Role Description

Key responsibilities

- Assist and support the Programme Coordinator with the Bramber Bakehouse baking programme;
- To work collaboratively with a team to ensure the workshop delivery runs smoothly including support with students who may need additional support during the baking workshops, preparing equipment and ingredients for each baking session and helping with washing up;
- Support in the physical set-up and clean-up of each workshop;
- Provide a friendly, warm environment to each woman attending the Bramber Bakehouse programme;
- Participate in the baking activities;
- Reflect on each session and make any suggestions and changes to the Programme Coordinator or other staff members.

Desirable criteria

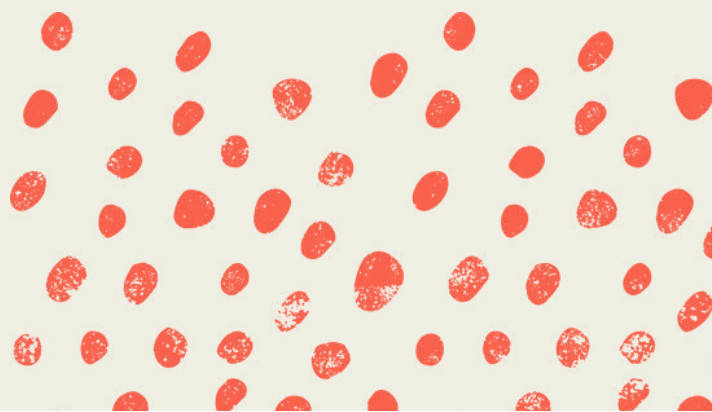
- Experience working with women survivors of trauma
