Although many of our staff and volunteers have a Christian faith, it is not a requirement for all roles within the organisation and is never a requirement of the women we work with.

For those looking to join the Bramber Bakehouse team, we ask that you are broadly in sympathy with the aims and ethos of the charity, helping us to deliver our vision to support women survivors of human trafficking. We ask applicants to be comfortable working within a faith-based organisation.

We seek to provide an inclusive environment for all the women we work alongside, respecting different faiths or none, ensuring that no judgement is made. The Bramber Bakehouse programme is non-discriminatory and everyone is treated equally no matter what faith background they may or may not have.
